ALLETE Clean Energy is an independent power producer established in 2011 with headquarters in Duluth, Minnesota. ALLETE Clean Energy, through subsidiaries, owns and operates wind farms in six states. The current development plan includes construction of up to 260 megawatts of renewable energy projects in 2018-2019 in North Dakota and Montana. The Glen Ullin Energy Center will be located in Mercer and Morton Counties in North Dakota.

What's Happening

The Glen Ullin Energy Center is a 106-megawatt wind farm that will begin producing wind-generated electricity in the fall of 2019. Before and during construction, we will host landowner meetings to keep participants apprised of the project's development schedule, milestones, and projected construction dates. Glen Ullin Energy Center is expected to be fully integrated into the community by late 2019.

Landowner Participation

Leased land allows the landowner to optimize land use. A small portion of the leased land is needed for siting turbines and development of access roads intended for mutual use. The remaining land continues to be available for landowner use, such as farming or grazing. This dual use provides additional annual income to landowners.

Community Support

The Glen Ullin Energy Center will provide direct community benefits through jobs, local business investment, and other contributions. We value the communities where we live and work, and we look forward to forging partnerships with landowners and the Glen Ullin community.

Project Schedule

Construction begins well before the delivery of the turbines. Before the first turbine is installed, the site layout is finalized, the operations and maintenance building and adjacent laydown yard are completed, access roads are built and the underground cabling system is installed.

Project Features

- 2.3 and 2.5-megawatt General Electric turbines
- 106-megawatt renewable energy capacity, enough to power about 35,000 homes
- Supports local business before, during and after construction
- Employs 250 people during construction and 10 people during operation
- Establishment of community development fund
- Energy for Glen Ullin Energy Center will be delivered to Xcel Energy under a signed power purchase agreement
- Turbines will be erected on a foundation of 450 cubic feet of concrete and 40 tons of reinforcing steel
